SUBJECT: SBA Form 1919 Updated for Executive Order 14168

EFFECTIVE: March 19, 2025

The purpose of this Notice is to announce that SBA is revising SBA Form 1919, “SBA 7(a) Borrower Information Form” in response to Executive Order (EO) [14168](#), “Defending Women From Gender Ideology Extremism and Restoring Biological Truth to the Federal Government”, issued January 20, 2025.

Per section (3)(e) of the EO, "Agencies shall remove all statements, policies, regulations, forms, communications, or other internal and external messages that promote or otherwise inculcate gender ideology, and shall cease issuing such statements, policies, regulations, forms, communications or other messages. Agency forms that require an individual's sex shall list male or female, and shall not request gender identity.”

SBA has revised SBA Form 1919 to replace the term “gender” with the term “sex” in 3 instances on pages 2 and 5 of the form. SBA has also removed “Not Disclosed” as a possible response to the “Sex” demographic information category on page 2, with the remaining options being “Male” and “Female”. The disclosure of demographic information, including sex, on SBA Form 1919 remains voluntary.

Lenders may download the revised SBA Form 1919 from SBA’s [website](#). The revised form may be used immediately; however, SBA will allow a 30-day grace period for 7(a) Lenders to begin using the revised form. The revised form will be dated February 2025 in the lower left corner.
